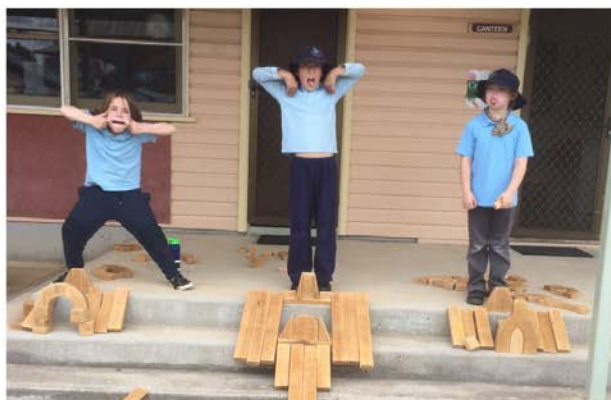

Domestic and Family Violence Talk – Gunning Library

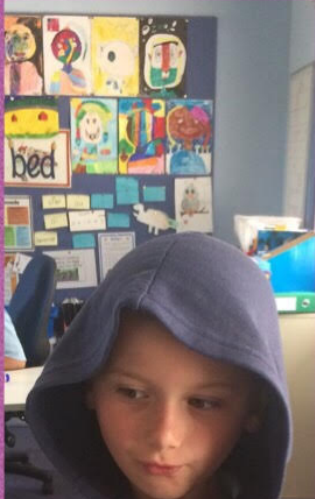
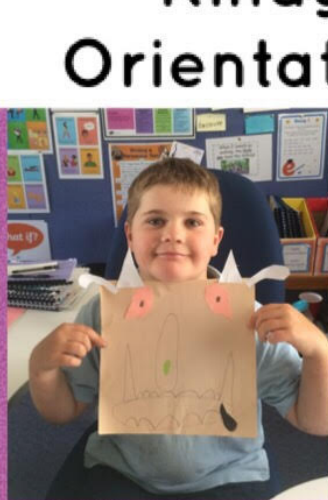
